SUBJECT: Jury Fees

Effective July 1, 2006, individuals who are summoned to serve as petit or grand jurors shall not be paid for the first day of service. After the first day of service, jurors shall be paid at the rate of \$25 per day. Jurors shall be paid the full rate regardless of whether the juror spends a full day or a half day in jury service. For purposes of Administrative Rule 15(j)(3), jury service begins the first day that a juror appears for jury service, even though the pay rate for the first day is \$0.

This bulletin is entered pursuant to the authority granted in Administrative Rule 14(g).

This bulletin was originally entered in June 2002 to reduce Alaska Court System operating costs, to address a reduction in maintenance level funding in the Alaska Court System's Fiscal Year 2003 operating budget. It was amended in 2003 because those funds were not restored in the Fiscal Year 2004 operating budget. It is amended now to provide a higher rate of pay for jurors who return after the first day, and to reduce the clerical burden of tracking and accounting for jurors' partial service days.

This bulletin will remain in effect until revoked.
