**ORDER SETTING DATES FOR SUSPENDED ANCHORAGE**  
**DISTRICT COURT HEARINGS**

In response to the public health emergency caused by the coronavirus pandemic, the Alaska Supreme Court ORDER #1957, The Chief Justice’s Special ORDER #8131 (Amended) and Presiding Judge Statewide Administrative Order Governing Relaxation and Suspension of Various Court Rules Based on the COVID-19 Pandemic issued on March 23, 2020, certain hearings have been suspended and some moved multiples time. The purpose of this DPJ Order #3 is to provide the parties with new dates for the hearings that have been suspended. These dates may again be moved depending on the evolution of the COVID-19 pandemic. Accordingly:

**I.     CRIMINAL TRIAL CALLS<sup>1</sup>**

1. All State and Municipal trial calls previously moved to April 1, 2020 are now further continued to May 6, 2020.
2. All State and Municipal trial calls previously moved to April 8, 2020 are now further continued to May 13, 2020.

<sup>1</sup> All criminal and civil trials remain suspended. Each Anchorage District Court Judge is moving their assigned civil trials to correlate with their respective assigned civil weeks to a date when the pandemic suspension may be lifted.

3. All State and Municipal trial calls previously scheduled for April 15, 2020 are now continued to May 20, 2020.
4. All State and Municipal trial calls previously schedule for April 22, and 29, 2020 are now continued to May 27, 2020.

## **II. CRIMINAL PRETRIAL CONFERENCES<sup>2</sup>**

5. All State and Municipal pretrial conferences previously moved to April 6, 2020 are now further continued to May 4, 2020.
6. All State and Municipal pretrial conferences previously moved to April 13, 2020 are now continued to May 11, 2020.
7. All State and Municipal pretrial conferences scheduled for April 20, 2020, are now continued to May 18, 2020.
8. All State and Municipal pretrial conferences scheduled for April 27, 2020, are now continued to May 26, 2020 (Monday is a holiday).
9. All State and Municipal pretrial conferences scheduled for May 4, 2020, are now continued to June 1, 2020.

## **III. FORCIBLE ENTRY AND DETAINERS**

10. All Forcible Entry and Detainer hearings currently set for April 6, 2020 are continued to May 8, 2020, at the time previously designated.
11. All Forcible Entry and Detainer hearings currently set for April 8, 2020 are continued to May 11, 2020, at the time previously designated.
12. All Forcible Entry and Detainer hearings currently set for April 10, 2020 are continued to May 13, 2020, at the time previously designated.
13. All Forcible Entry and Detainer hearings currently set for April 13, 2020 are continued to May 15, 2020, at the time previously designated.
14. All Forcible Entry and Detainer hearings currently set for April 15, 2020 are continued to May 18, 2020, at the time previously designated.
15. All Forcible Entry and Detainer hearings currently set for April 17, 2020 are continued to May 20, 2020, at the time previously designated.
16. All Forcible Entry and Detainer hearings currently set for April 20, 2020 are continued to May 22, 2020, at the time previously designated.

<sup>2</sup> All civil pretrial conferences remain suspended. Each Anchorage District Court Judge is moving their assigned civil pretrial conferences to correlate with their respective assigned civil weeks to a date when the pandemic suspension may be lifted.

17. All Forcible Entry and Detainer hearings currently set for April 22, 2020 are continued to May 27, 2020, (Monday is a holiday) at the time previously designated.
18. All Forcible Entry and Detainer hearings currently set for April 24, 2020 are continued to May 29, 2020, at the time previously designated.
19. All Forcible Entry and Detainer hearings currently set for April 27, 2020 are continued to June 1, 2020, at the time previously designated.
20. All Forcible Entry and Detainer hearings currently set for April 29, 2020 are continued to June 3, 2020, at the time previously designated.
21. All Forcible Entry and Detainer hearings currently set for May 1, 2020 are continued to June 5, 2020, at the time previously designated.

#### **IV. SPECIAL CALENDAR/MOTION CALL/REP HEARINGS<sup>3</sup>**

22. The 1:00 p.m. Special Calendar/Motion Call and Representation Hearings currently set for April 6, 2020, are continued to May 11, 2020.
23. The 1:00 p.m. Special Calendar/Motion Call and Representation Hearings currently set for April 13, 2020, are continued to May 18, 2020.
24. The 1:00 p.m. Special Calendar/Motion Call and Representation Hearings currently set for April 20, 2020, are continued to June 1, 2020. (Monday, May 25, 2020, is a holiday).
25. The 1:00 p.m. Special Calendar/Motion Call and Representation Hearings currently set for April 27, 2020, are continued to June 8, 2020.

#### **V. MISDEMEANOR DISPOSITION HEARINGS**

26. All Friday morning disposition hearings calendared for April 10, 2020 are continued to May 15, 2020.
27. All Friday morning disposition hearings calendared for April 17, 2020 are continued to May 22, 2020.
28. All Friday morning disposition hearings calendared for April 24 and May 1, are continued to May 29, 2020.

#### **VI. OTHER MATTERS**

29. Any case that has already been continued by the parties beyond these dates will remain as set.
