All pre-trial conferences scheduled for Wednesday, May 27, 2020 in front of Judge Traini are continued to Monday, June 15, 2020.


All Temporary And Transport Orders For The Original Dates Listed Above Are Hereby Continued To The New Dates Without Further Orders Necessary.

These circumstances provide good cause under Alaska Criminal Rule 45 (d)(7) to postpone these pretrial conference and associated trial dates. Once the suspension or limitation is lifted, Criminal Rule 45 is tolled for at least an additional 30 days to permit an orderly transition and scheduling. This order is made pursuant to the April 3, 2020 First Updated Presiding Judges' Statewide Administrative Order Governing Relaxation and Suspension of Various Court Rules Based on the COVID-19 Pandemic and March 19, 2020 Special Order of the Chief Justice Order No. 8131.

Any litigant who wishes to bring a matter concerning their case to the attention of the court may file a motion addressing the issues that need to be addressed in that individual case.

The situation regarding the coronavirus pandemic is changing rapidly. The court will issue further orders as necessary.
