PRESIDING JUDGES' STATEWIDE ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER GOVERNING ELECTRONIC SIGNATURES OF JUDICIAL OFFICERS

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic the chief justice issued Special Order No. 8135 (20 April 2020). It authorized various practices that would minimize the need for ! litigants to interact in person with court staff. Filing parties were authorized to sign documents with "an electronic signature or type 's/[name]/' on the signature line."

Because of the quarantine and isolation orders put into place in response to the pandemic, at times a judicial officer must work remotely away from his or her chambers.

A judicial officer may sign documents, including orders, judgments, writs, and warrants with an electronic signature or type's/[name]/' on the signature line.
