***Fine Schedule:** Pursuant to AS 29.25.070(a) a municipality may allow disposition of a violation without court appearance <u>and establish a schedule of fine amounts for each offense</u>. A fine schedule is a table or list of offenses, which includes the code section where the offense is defined, the offense description and the fine amount for that offense. It must state that the offenses listed can be disposed of without a court appearance by payment of the fine and must describe the procedure for disposing of the charges.

****Mandatory Court Appearance Offense:** Any offense <u>not</u> listed on a fine schedule is automatically a mandatory court appearance offense. The defendant cannot dispose of these offenses by paying a fine, but must appear in court to answer to the charges.

*****Driving of Motor Vehicles:** AS 28.15.221(a) requires the assignment of points for violations of traffic laws, which are defined in AS 28.15.261. Points are assigned by DMV. See the point system in 2 AAC 90.310.
