The pre-judgment interest on total amount in section 4

Find the interest rate set by a statutory formula for the year the court enters the judgment in your case. Most debts use the same interest rates (which may change annually), but some kinds of debts have their own interest rates, such as child support arrearages (see AS 25.27.025). To figure out the pre-judgment interest amount, use the following formula:

$$\frac{\text{Total Amount Owed} \times \text{Interest Rate}}{100 \div 365} \times \text{\# of Days*} = \text{Amount of Interest Due for that Period}$$

* “# of Days” means the number of days between the date due listed in the chart on page 1 and the date you file your motion.

EXAMPLE

Motion to Reduce to Judgment is filed November 22, 2021, claiming \$1,000 was not paid. The money has been due since March 16, 2021.
