- 7. **Mediation is voluntary.** Participants must attend the initial meeting with the mediator and the first joint mediation session. If a participant thinks mediation is not helpful, that participant may choose to return to court. Deciding not to mediate will not bias the court's future decisions.
- 8. If your mediation is by phone or Zoom, make sure that no one else is around you or can overhear the mediation. If you are attending a mediation in person, please note that childcare is not provided.
