## **Purpose of Hearing**

At the hearing, the court will decide whether the respondent needs a court order to perform this transaction, because either

- (1) the respondent is an **adult** who is unable to manage the respondent's own money and property effectively, and:
  - the respondent has money or property that will be wasted or used up unless proper management is provided, or
  - the respondent has funds that are needed for the support, care, and welfare of the respondent or those entitled to be supported by the respondent.

(2) the respondent is a **minor** who

- has money or owns property needing management or protection, and a court order is necessary to provide this management or protection, or
- has or may have business affairs that may be negatively affeced because the respondnt is a minor, or
- needs money for support and education, and a protective order is necessary to get access to this money.

The court will also determine whether this transaction is in the respondent's best interests.

## **Possible Consequences**

The court may order the transaction to proceed without requiring the respondent's consent, although the court will consider the respondent's opinion, if reasonably possible to do so.
