AMENDED STANDING ORDER RE:  
TELEPHONIC PARTICIPATION

In order to better manage court business, the court hereby orders that the following procedures be used for telephonic participation:

1. Geographic Range: All parties/attorneys living within a 50 mile radius of the Kenai court must appear in person absent *exceptional* circumstances and prior, written permission from the court. The radius includes Nikiski, Sterling, Kasilof and Clam Gulch. It does not include Cooper Landing.
2. Advance Permission: In each case where counsel and/or a party has an address of record 50 miles or more away from the court, this order grants permission to appear by phone for routine hearings. *No requests for telephonic permission are required.* Forms used in other courts, such as “applications to appear by telephone without confirmation pursuant to Civ. R. 99” will not be accepted.
3. The court reserves the right to revoke telephonic participation at any time.
