

**Uniform Administrative Order Establishing a Statewide Policy of Making In-Custody Arraignments Available Within 24 Hours of Arrest.**


This order is adopted pursuant to Administrative Rule 46 and goes into effect in all judicial districts on July 1, 2011

**Order:** Each judicial district shall maintain the judicial resources necessary to arraign defendants within 24 hours of arrest, including weekends and holidays.




