You are invited to register for the National Center for State Courts (NCSC) written examination for court interpreters. The examination will be administered by the Alaska Court System.

Date of the Exam: **Friday, 7/12/2019**

Time: Exam begins at **9:30 a.m.**
All candidates must be present and ready to begin the exam at 9:15 a.m.

Location: Snowden Administration Building
820 W. 4th Avenue, Anchorage, AK.

Registration: Interpreter candidate **MUST** register with Stefanie Burich sburich@akcourts.us **no later than Friday, July 5.**
Registrations received after July 5 will not be accepted.

Exam Fee: None

You are eligible to take the written exam because you have successfully completed:

- all registration requirements with the LIC;
- the LIC interpreter training program; and
- the court-specific interpreter training class.

Once you register with Stefanie Burich, you will receive more information about what to expect on exam day such as:

- when to arrive at the testing site;
- what you may and may not bring to the exam room; and
- identification documents required.

The NCSC written examination is in English and has 135 multiple-choice questions covering general English proficiency, court-related terms and usage, and ethics/professional conduct required of court interpreters. To read more about the written exam go to:
