1. I am the director of the Division of Elections for the State of Alaska, and I have personal knowledge of the matters in this affidavit. I was appointed as director in February 2023.

2. Federal and state law require the Division to mail absentee ballots to uniformed, overseas, and state advance voters by Saturday, July 4, 2026—forty-five days before the primary election. The Division will send ballots to about 1,580 of these voters.

3. These ballots are processed through the United States Postal Service bulk mail facility in Anchorage. Bulk mail is not available on Saturdays and July 4 is a federal holiday, so the Division must mail these ballots on Friday, July 3.

4. These ballots will be printed by the Division in-house, rather than by a print vendor. To print, fold, and insert these ballots, the Division must begin printing ballots by June 30 at noon.

5. Any delay in ballot printing after June 30 at noon will cause the Division to miss the mailing deadlines in federal and state law.

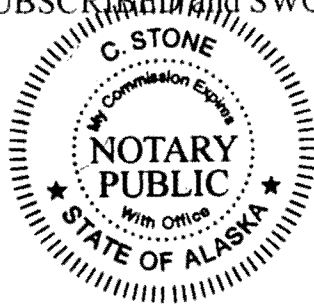
6. The Division will not print or mail any ballots before June 30 at noon.
