**DEFENDANT'S UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE
OPPOSITION TO MOTION FOR ATTORNEYS' FEES**

The Governor filed a motion asking that attorneys' fee litigation in this matter be stayed pending appeal or in the alternative that a reasonable extension be granted to file an opposition to the plaintiff's and intervenor's motions for fees. The court signed an order denying the request for a stay on February 2, 2020, and setting a deadline of February 14, 2020, for the Governor's opposition.

However, it appears that the order was not distributed because neither the plaintiff nor the defendant received it. After counsel for the Legislature noticed the order listed on Courtview and alerted the parties to its existence with an email to the court requesting a copy, the Governor then sent someone to the court to request a copy in person.

Because the order was not received until yesterday, February 11, 2020, the Governor asks the Court to extend the deadline for his opposition until February 21, 2020. Both the Legislature and the intervenors have indicated that they do not oppose this motion.
