**ORDER DEEMING CASE MOTION #7 MOOT; ORDER REGARDING
PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION**


The court understands that the parties came to an agreement regarding a stipulated stay of this case while the Alaska Supreme Court decides Defendants' *Petition for Review*. The Alaska Supreme Court granted the stipulated stay. Accordingly, the court will rule out Case Motion #7 (whereby Defendants sought a stay of this case from the trial court) as MOOT.

The parties have also submitted a stipulated *[Proposed] Preliminary Injunction Order*. The court is prepared to sign the order. However, the court believes it would be best to wait until the Alaska Supreme Court decides the *Petition*, and to promptly sign the

order if the Alaska Supreme Court affirms this court -- issuing the order now could possibly cause confusion for the general public.

While the court will hold the proposed *Order* as outlined above, the court expects that, per Paragraph 13 of the proposed *Order*, Defendants will be fully prepared and ready to effectuate immediately all the relief set forth in the proposed *Order*, with the exception of printing postcards and making television advertisements, without further delay.
