

Barton LeBon and the Alaska Republican Party have filed a motion to intervene. The motion includes a suggestion that the intervenors may challenge other ballots not referenced in the current appeal. Additional challenges may affect the schedule for preparation of the agency record and the litigation of the issues referred to the special master. Kathryn Dodge and the appellees have had an opportunity to respond to this motion.

IT IS ORDERED that the motion to intervene is **GRANTED**. However, the intervenors must file a cross-appeal regarding any additional ballots by **3:30 p.m. today**.
