**SECOND MOTION FOR EXPEDITED CONSIDERATION OF

COMES NOW Plaintiff, Stanley Allen Vezey, by and through his attorney of record, The Law Offices of William R. Satterberg, Jr., and hereby moves this court, for the second time, to consider the underlying Motion for Declaratory Judgment and Preliminary Injunction on a shortened basis.
