Adding new Administrative Rule 43.13  
concerning Wildland Fire Bail Forfeiture  
Schedule.

**IT IS ORDERED:**

New Administrative Rule 43.13 is adopted to read as follows:

**Rule 43.13. Wildland Fire Bail Forfeiture Schedule**

Pursuant to AS 41.15.960 and 41.15.140(2), when committed without any culpable mental state, the following offenses may be disposed of without court appearance upon payment and forfeiture of the bail amounts listed. If a person charged with one of these offenses appears in court and is convicted, the penalty imposed for the offense may not exceed the bail amount for that offense listed below.

<u>AS 41.15.070</u>	<u>Discarding burning materials on forested land</u>	<u>\$300</u>
<u>AS 41.15.090(a)</u>	<u>Failure to clear ground of flammable materials before starting a fire</u>	<u>100</u>
<u>AS 41.15.090(b)</u>	<u>After starting a fire in or near forested land, failure to totally extinguish the fire</u>	<u>500</u>

<u>AS 41.15.100</u>	<u>Setting a fire on forested land without the consent of the owner or lawful occupant</u>	<u>250</u>
<u>11 AAC 95.412(a)</u>	<u>Failure to obtain burn permit</u>	<u>100</u>
<u>11 AAC 95.412(b)(1) &amp; (2)</u>	<u>Failure to possess/display permit at burn site</u>	<u>100</u>
<u>11 AAC 95.414</u>	<u>Failure to comply with small sale burn permit</u>	<u>100</u>
<u>11 AAC 95.416</u>	<u>Failure to comply with large scale burn permit</u>	<u>250</u>
<u>11 AAC 95.450(c)</u>	<u>Burning during emergency burn closure</u>	<u>500</u>
<u>11 AAC 95.470</u>	<u>Burning materials that produce black, obnoxious, or toxic smoke</u>	<u>250</u>
